Scholarship Amount: \$1,500

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the First Command Educational Foundation and East Bay Coast Guard Spouses Club 2018 scholarship, the applicant must be a military dependent. Military dependents are the spouse(s), children, and possibly other familial relationship categories of a sponsoring military member for purposes of pay as well as special benefits, privileges and rights. If you are selected for the scholarship, you will need to provide us with your military ID for verification.

Family members of First Command Financial Services (FCFS) home office employees, FCFS advisors, and employees of FCFS advisors, are **not eligible** for advisor-sponsored awards. Family members are defined as any relative by birth or marriage.

Requirements:

To be considered for this scholarship please provide the East Bay Coast Guard Spouses Club with the following no later than May 25, 2018.

- The completed application, including essay.
- Basic Financial Course Requirement

All scholarship applicants must complete either Basic\$4ALL (mobile) or Basic\$4ALL (online) and submit the certificate of completion with their application to be eligible to receive a FCEF scholarship award.

Basic\$4ALL (mobile) is a free smartphone app that covers fundamental topics in personal finance and is available in the App Store.

Basic\$4ALL (online) is a free, web-based course that provides a brief introduction to spending plans, basic banking and accounts, credit, debt and loans, and investing. Each course takes less than one hour. The certificate of completion for each course is sent to the email address provided by the scholarship recipient.
